


Dogwood's Origins


- Created from sale of Mission Health
- Private foundation
 - Manage and grow the endowment for the region
 - Governed by a volunteer board of directors and regulated by the IRS
 - Make investments in community: 5% of assets each year



The Economic Landscape: Cost of Living

- Cost of a 2-bedroom apartment
- o 18% of income in NC
 o 25% of income in WNC
 o High % driven by low wages





The Economic Landscape: Disparities

- Median Household Income in NC*:
 - White families \$70,780
 - o Black families \$45,007
 - Latino/Hispanic families \$48,244
- Nationally, black unemployment is nearly double that of white Americans**
- o Entrepreneurship
 - Buncombe County average annual business sales***:
 - Black-owned businesses \$40K
 - White-owned businesses \$400K
 - Nationally, BIPOC-owned firms make up 15% of all businesses and only 3% of gross sales


